Fine Art: Rick J. Delanty is a plein air and studio painter, with nationally-recognized awards. He has participated in exhibitions and plein air competitions across the United States. He paints in both, oils and acrylics, painting in solvent-free oils outdoors and acrylics in the studio. He has exhibited six times at the Laguna Beach Festival of the Arts, five of those years as a large-scale watercolorist. He has been selected nine times for the Laguna Beach Plein Air Invitational, in which he was honored to receive both the Boseker and Surfrider Awards. In 2016, he was selected to participate in the Maui Plein Air Invitational. Rick has been invited as juror and demonstrator for several art organizations, and served as curator for LPAPA's exhibition of over one hundred contemporary landscapes in the galleries of the Huntington Beach Art Center. He is a Signature member of Laguna Plein Air Painters Association, the International Society of Acrylic Painters, the American Impressionists Society, and California Plein Air Painters (CPAP).

Photography: Jeff Alu is an award-winning photographer whose work has been shown in over 70 photographic exhibitions worldwide. His work has been featured in Black and White Magazine, Lenswork Magazine, and he is published online on sites such as the aCurator Blog and the Art Photo Index. He has curated numerous photographic exhibitions at venues such as the Orange County Center for Contemporary Art and the Los Angeles Center for Digital Art, and has been a juror for the Mobile Photography Awards, as well as the Orange County Fair. He has given photography-related presentations to organizations such as the Marks Art Center and the Disney Imagineering photography group.

***Pickup of Non-Juried In Art:** Tuesday, June 28th & Wednesday, June 29th, 11:00am to 4:00pm.

***Gallery Open:** Saturday, July 2nd through Friday, July 29th, 12pm to 5pm daily, closed on Mondays, Tuesdays & Wednesdays. Parking is available in the parking structure located at 3rd Street and Sycamore St.

***Reception and Award Ceremony:** Saturday, July 30th 1:00pm to 3:00pm

***Pickup of Art:** Immediately after the completion of award ceremony.

CATEGORIES:

Fine Arts 1) Oils; 2) Acrylics; 3) Watercolors; 4) Pastels/Drawing/Illustration – Hand-drawn, pencil, ink, etc. without use of computer; 5) Mixed Media/Collage/Other Media; 6) Three Dimensional (may include sculpture done in traditional media, constructions, assemblages, suspended forms, soft sculpture and light forms).

Photography 7) Black & White Photo/Prints (Must be a print from a single original exposure. Sepia-toned prints are acceptable. Multiple images and other types of toned images must be entered in Non-Traditional Prints); 8) Color Photo/Prints (Must be a color print from a single, original exposure. High Dynamic Range photos are acceptable. Multiple images must be entered in Non-Traditional Prints); 9) Non-Traditional Photo/Prints.

Note: There will be a Best of Show from both Fine Art and Photography Classes.

GENERAL GUIDELINES: ANY category with 12 or fewer accepted entries will be combined with the next smaller category (Fine Art or Photo). Categories with 13 or more will receive 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place awards. Honorable Mention ribbons will be awarded at the judge's discretion.

RULES:

ELIGIBILITY: The 20th Annual Orange Open is open to all artists 18 and over.

*No work that has won awards in any previous Orange Open will be accepted.

*Entries must be original. No work done in a class or workshop will be accepted, nor will giclees or reproduction prints.

*. Source material must be original and not derived from any published images accepted (except for photography).

* No restriction to the date completed.

* All works must be properly framed or painted gallery wrapped with wire; no saw-tooth hangers will be accepted. No wet paintings.

* **Size restrictions:** No art will be accepted that is larger than 8 feet in any direction Sculpture is limited to 50 lbs. including base.

* No entry shall be permitted to have another media on top of a photograph, print or giclee'

* Once entered, all artwork will remain in the gallery for the duration of the show.

* The show chairmen will resolve all issues or questions concerning entries, categories, or submissions.

Any violation of the rules could lead to disqualification and/or loss of any award.

ENTRY FEES: Non-members, \$30 for 1st entry, \$25 each for 2-7 entries; OAA members, \$15 for 1st entry, \$10 each for 2-7 entries. You may join the OAA by including a completed membership form and \$25 with the entry fee.

Note: Returned check fees of \$10.00 will be the responsibility of the entrant.

There is a limit of (7) entries per artist, but no more than (3) entries shall be presented in the show and the possibility no works are juried in. No artist will receive more than (1) award from the juror.

ENTRY FORM & FEES: To be eligible, your entry form must be fully completed and **signed** and be accompanied by your entry fee, in full, in U.S. currency via cash, check, money order or cashier's check payable to Orange Art Association. Entry fees are not refundable.

NOTE: Artwork not picked up on time is subject to a \$5.00 per day storage fee per piece.

DISCLAIMER: While every effort will be made to protect and care for your entry, the Orange Art Association or its representatives will not be held responsible for any loss or damage.

SALES: Because OCCCA venue is a professional gallery, any sales made during the show, 45% of the sales price will go to the OCCCA and club. Price artwork submissions accordingly.
